**Biography**

After finishing her medical school at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Aligarh, India, Varshney finished her anatomic and clinical pathology residency training at the University of Toledo Medical Center, Ohio. Subsequently, she did her surgical pathology fellowship at the University of Iowa, Iowa City, and a gastrointestinal and hepato-pancreatobiliary pathology fellowship at the University of Arizona.

The author or coauthor of 12 articles in peer-reviewed publications, eight book chapters and 40 abstracts and poster presentations, Varshney has given 12 invited presentations at scientific meetings nationally. She is the recipient of several research awards and serves as a reviewer or on the editorial boards of 15 scientific journals. She is an active member of several professional societies, including the United States and Canadian Academy of Pathologists, the College of American Pathologists and the American Society of Clinical Pathologists.
