Siniša Franjić live in Osijek, Croatia. Primary and two secondary schools ended in Osijek, and graduated from the Faculty of Law of the University of Split. Since 1992., he works as a journalist - freelance contributor to the first Radio Osijek of HRT (Croatian Radio Television), and then something shorter, among other media, he works for HTV - TV center Osijek, weekly "Školske novine (School Newspaper)" and the monthly "Super Kino Video (Super Cinema video)".
